How to Edit Preferences in Degree Planner

Step 1: "Degree"

During the first two weeks of each semester:

- Open Degree Planner: Login to MyCSUSM and Click Student Center. Click Degree Planner. Click Continue to proceed.
- 2. Review the number of units suggested in the upcoming semester.

Most students will not have to make any changes in this step as the Degree Planner default suggestion is approximately 15 units.
