Action	Description: The Board of Directors will take action on a	ASI President &
	resolution regarding the work of the CSUSM Smoke and	CEO
	Tobacco-Free Campus Implementation Task Force. Student	
	Advocacy Committee recommended approval of the	
	resolution with amendments.	
	Fiscal Impact: None	
	Discussion centered on Student Advocacy supporting the	
	task force efforts but not policy so two paragraphs were	
	removed from the original resolution. So, now the	
	resolution simply supports the education and task force	
	efforts on CSUSM going smoke & tobacco free.	
	Chris M. wondered if there should be something added	
	about the Board not supporting criminalization of smoking	
	on campus but mentioning that they do not support giving	
	citations for those who do smoke on campus. Michael	
	McDuffie spoke to this since he is a member of the task	
	force. He mentioned that the efforts will be educational to	
	bring awareness to the campaign. Enforcement will be	
	focused on communication and reinforcement of the	
	education. He mentioned that there is no intention of having	
	a punitive approach but one with civil enforcement. He	
	acknowledged that the committee needs to be realistic in	
	the expectations of students going smoke free.	
	Collin also mentioned that the resolution supports their	
	efforts but also assumes good intent of the committee &
