POLICY:	STUDENT EMERGENCY FUND	
EFFECTIVE DATE:	JANUARY 11, 2016	
APPROVAL DATE:	JUNE 22, 2018	

PURPOSE

The Student Emergency Fund (SEF) provides compassionate assistance to <u>currrently enrolled CSUSM</u> students who encounter unforeseen financial emergencies or catastrophic events that disrupt their progress toward a degree. These funds are not intended to be used for routine expenses nor as a consistent supplement to a student's education funding sources. <u>These funds are not required to be repaid</u>

POLICY AND PROCEDURES

- A) Funding for Student Emergency Fund is determined annually during the ASI budget allocation process in the spring for the subsequent fiscal year.
- B) Funds for Student Emergency Fund are managed by and contained within the budget of the ASI Executive Vice President.


