He brings up that not all students have an ideal testing workspace. He asked the questions that if there are other resources that when it comes to testing is there a better system to use?</p> <p>Jacqueline discussed students' complaints and how not all students have enough resources when it comes to testing and using Lockdown Browser. When the browser is being used and students have issues, students are often kicked off the test and bring stress and anxiety on the students.</p> <p>Caleb also brings awareness to Privacy Concerns. Professors are asking students to download these browsers that computers are being accessed too, while students might keep sensitive stuff on their computers.</p> <p>Jason talked about how he visited a few of the student life centers and those students have too brought up the same concern.
