| 08 Discussion | <p>Roundtable Discussion Description: Student Representative discuss student concerns & issues Fiscal Impact: None</p> <p>Discussion focused on proposed changes to the spring 2021 semester schedule. Academic Senate is currently discussing options. Caleb mentioned that students from SDSU are not in favor of the changes to the spring semester and asked to communicate to the Academic Senate. Ksenia also has heard that students are not in favor of the changes to the spring semester and asked for more detail on the changes. Jason elaborates on the changes in the spring semester and how in person classes will be on hold. A concern was that if an increase of COVID cases happens that after spring break all in-person classes will be discontinued. Jason reviews and shared 4 different options of the changes that can happen for the upcoming Spring Break. Jacqueline mentions that she has heard from her COBA students are in favor of the distributed dates. Ashley asked the reasoning for ending the semester early. Jason answered is also unclear of that answer and taking it away would prevent people from leaving campus and bringing something back and having an increase in cases. Andrew mentions that the Academic Senate is looking at options 1 and 2 and that a meeting is scheduled for next Wednesday. There was additional clarification made about meeting schedule.</p> <p>Further discussion focused on credit no credit option for fall 2020 semester. Caleb mentions that students are asking if credit no credit will be coming back. Julia mentions that her and Sherry meet with APC and looking at credit no credit and a meeting is scheduled to talk further about the topic. Ksenia mentioned that students are in favor of the credit no credit. She has also heard that even though students are able to do their classes but they would still like the option of interest.
