Fall 2023

- Apply to CSUSM** (October 1st– November 30th)
 - Apply to CSUSM by completing the Cal State Apply application via <https://www2.calstate.edu/apply/freshman>.
 - Application fee is \$70. Students can apply for an application fee waiver via Cal State Apply, if eligible you can receive up to 4 fee waivers.
 - **AB540:** Visit <https://www.csusm.edu/undocumented/admissions/index.html> or contact the CSUSM Admissions Office for more information at (760) 750-4056.
 - **EOP:** Students are highly encouraged to apply for the Educational Opportunity Program (EOP).
 - The EOP application is available for you to complete along with your Cal State Apply application.

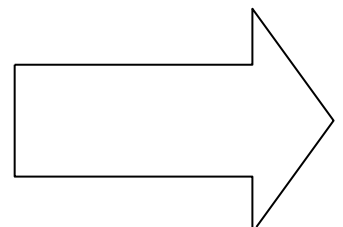
- Apply for Financial Aid** (Application opens in December 2023)
 - Complete the FAFSA via www.fafsa.ed.gov using 2022 income tax information.
 - You are highly recommended to complete your 2024-2025 FAFSA application as soon as possible so you can receive all financial aid awards that you are eligible for.
 - October 1st, 2023 is the deadline for the FSEOG grant.

- CSUSM General Scholarship** (October 1st– February 1st)
 - Complete the “CSUSM General Scholarship” application for the opportunity to receive additional free money at https://www.csusm.edu/finaid/scholarships/csusm_scholarship.html

- Activate MyCSUSM Student Center** (within 3 weeks of submitting Cal State Apply application)
 - Activate your account using your CSUSM student ID number.
 - Your student ID number will be emailed to you within two weeks of applying to CSUSM.

- Complete CAMP Interest Form** (Deadline: December 30th)
 - Visit: <https://www.csusm.edu/camp/prospectivestudents/campinterestform.html> and complete the form to secure your spot on our CAMP student potential list.

Spring 2024

- Apply for CAMP, priority application** (Deadline: March 8, 2024)
 - Available at www.csusm.edu/camp
 - Priority registration for 1st year CSUSM courses will be granted for priority applicants.
- Continue to log in to MyCSUSM Student Center**
 - Check your MyCSUSM student center <https://my.csusm.edu> weekly for:
 - Application Status
 - “To-Do list”
- CSUSM General Scholarship** (Deadline: February 1st)
 - Complete “CSUSM General Scholarship” application for the opportunity to receive additional free money at <http://www.csusm.edu/finaid/scholarships/index.html>
- Activate Cal Grant** (March 2nd)
 1. Create an account at <https://mygrantinfo.csac.ca.gov/>
 2. Verify High School GPA.
 3. Verify “California State University San Marcos” as selected school of attendance.
- Complete Intent to Enroll** (CAMP Priority: April)
 - Once offered admission to CSUSM, submit intent to enroll by May 1st with a \$150 enrollment deposit. If fee waiver is granted for Cal State Apply, then fee waiver is granted for intent to enroll fee.
 1. Log onto MyCSUSM student center <https://my.csusm.edu>Click on “Accept or Decline”, and then click on “accept” to submit intent to enroll.
- Participate in CAMP Mandatory Overview** (April 27th)
 - All potential CAMP students must attend the CAMP Overview with their parents to be considered for the program.
- Participate in CSUSM Specialized Programs Freshman Orientation** (June)
 - All potential CAMP students must register to attend the CSUSM Specialized Programs Freshman Orientation in June through MyCSUSM “student center” by May 1st
 - Fee deferment available if eligible, contact CAMP Academic Advisor.
- Submit Final High School Grades to CAMP** (CAMP Priority: June 30th)
 - All potential CAMP students must provide a copy of final grades to the CAMP Office (e.g. *unofficial high school transcript, report card, student portal report, etc.*)
- Submit Final Official High School Transcript to CSUSM** (CAMP Priority: July 1st)
 - Request official transcripts to be sent to CSUSM (e-mail or hard copy) before your last day of classes so they can be mailed as soon as you graduate high school.
- Complete AP Exams**
 - CAMP encourages students to take AP Exams, scores with a 3 or higher may receive college credit by sending official scores to CSUSM.
