



**2024 Scholarship and Creative Works Champion

The 2024 Scholarship and Creative Works Champion Award is an annual recognition of a graduating student who is earning a CHABSS bachelor's degree and has demonstrated outstanding achievements in research and/or creative works during their tenure at California State University San Marcos. This honor is bestowed upon one undergraduate student each academic year graduating with a degree from the College and has made a significant contribution to our institutions' mission of Intellectual Engagement & Innovation.

Award Process:

1. Nominations are due **Wednesday, March 13**. Nominations may be submitted to the Dean's Office via email to Leo Melena (lmelena@csusm.edu).
2. The Dean will make the final selection.
3. The CHABSS Dean's Office will notify all nominees of the decision at the Annual CHABSS Student Recognition on Tuesday, May 7, 2024. All nominators, nominees and their families are invited.

Criteria:

- Completion of a CHABSS bachelor's degree in Fall 2023, Spring 2024, or Summer 2024.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75.

Completed Nomination Packets must include the following:

- A faculty recommendation supporting the nominee's achievements in scholarship and/or creative works.
- A resume that includes a history of research and/or creative works. Examples include, but are not limited to:
 - oral or poster presentations
 - translation into other languages or media
 - artistic creation and/or presentations, performances, recitals, or exhibits
 - films, videos, or other media projects
 - refereed publications
 - published book chapters, books, music, scripts, poetry
- A personal statement from the nominee regarding the significance of their efforts in research and/or creative works and as it relates to the attainment of their college degree, generally, and in their major, specifically (300 words max.)
