Register for a CSUSM University Orientation by June 1.
Orientation is designed to help incoming students feel welcomed and a part of the CSUSM community. Summer 2023 Orientation programs will be a two-part component- complete an online module (Go2Orientation) prior to attending the in-person orientation. Available dates vary for each student depending on major. Orientation reservation questions may be directed to <u>New Student and Family Programs</u> .

New EOP Transfer students can sign up for any summer Orientation date.
Register for an Orientation by logging onto your <u>MyCSUSM Portal!</u> Failure to attend CSUSM Orientation will result in courses being dropped.
Submit Intent to Enroll & Deposit:
Your Intent to Enroll and the \$150 Enrollment Deposit must be submitted by May 1st.
Failure to submit the intent to enroll and enrollment deposit by the deadline will result in cancellation of your offer of admission.
You can submit your Intent to Enroll and pay the Deposit on <u>MyCSUSM</u> . Once you have logged in, select "Student Center," then select "Accept" or "Decline" for your fall application. If you select "Accept," you are required to complete all the steps to accept the offer of admission. Enable pop-ups on your web browser to proceed with making your payment online.
The \$150 Enrollment Deposit is non-refundable and will apply toward your first term tuition. The Enrollment Deposit will be waived only for students who qualified for a fee-waiver at the time of application. Contact <u>CSUSM Admission</u> at 760-750-4848 for any questions regarding the fee waiver.
EOP First Contact: Failure to attend EOP First Contact will result in being denied from EOP.
First contact is a <i>mandatory event</i> that welcomes and introduces new EOP Transfer students to EOP Program Services, EOP Student Contract, and a review of Transfer Bridge Programming. <mark>Students must attend ONE of the below sessions.</mark>

5:00pm on July 15.

Electronic transcripts can be provided through external or third-party vendors (Credential Solutions, eTranscriptCA,	
National Student Clearinghouse, Parchment, etc.). When ordering your transcript, please choose California State
