Oceanside Bridge Housing

<u>Purpose</u>

- Provide safe housing for individual clients experiencing chronic homelessness with a permanent plan
- Referrals Mechanism: HOT and HA
- Services to provide:
 - 3 units/12 beds
 - Social Integration Support
 - 24/7 onsite support
 - Housing Navigation

Oceanside Bridge Expansion Motel Program

- Provided non-congregate shelter setting with Bridge Housing Services
- 15 rooms set aside for non-congregate transitional sheltering
- Program relied on City Partners and Vendors
- Program prioritized on the following:
 - Homeless families with minor or dependent children
 - High-risk homeless residents for COVID-19
 - Homeless residents with housing plan


Oceanside Bridge Housing

- October 1, 2019 September 1st, 2020
- Residents Served: 50
- Exited to Permanent Housing: 70%
- Currently in Process: 18%
- Exited program unsuccessfully: 12%

Unsuccessful Plans

- 1 (high risk) wanted to live on a boat upon exit from the motel but refused to accept assistance in boat search.
- 1 exited to the VA Hospital due to needing a higher level of care.
- 4 exited on there own.
 - Not compliant with program rules that put themselves or others safety in jeopardy.



Performance Outcomes 2020-YTD


- Client Count: <u>581</u>


