Why Student Orgs and YOU matter





Alumni who were involved rate their time at CSUSM as some of the best years of their life.

Students involved in at least 1 co-curricular activity/week are more likely to land a job within six months of graduation.

Involved students are retained at higher graduation rates and perform better academically than students who are not involved.









CSU Executive Order 1068

CSU system-wide policy governing Student Organizations



RECOGNITION REQUIREMENTS

PRESIDENT,
TREASURER & ADVISOR

Required for all orgs

- PRESIDENT &
 TREASURER
 REQUIREMENTS:
 - Maintain 2.0 GPA
 - Be in good standing with the university

CONSTITUTION

Must be on file with SLIC. Any changes must be reported. CURRENT ROSTER

Maintain on Tukwut Trax. Must include Officers and minimum of 5 members.

MANDATORY TRAININGS

President, Treasurer, & Advisor

CSU/CAMPUS POLICIES

Open membership, student conduct, etc.






