# WHY GET INVOLVED?



Alumni who were involved rate their time at CSUSM as some of the best years of their life.



Students involved in at least 1 co-curricular activity/week are more likely to land a job within six months of graduation.



Involved students are retained at higher graduation rates and perform better academically than students who are not involved.

# RECOGNITION REQUIREMENTS

**1**

## **PRESIDENT, TREASURER & ADVISOR**

Required for all orgs

**2**

## **PRESIDENT & TREASURER REQUIREMENTS:**

- Maintain 2.0 GPA
- Be in good standing with the university

**3**

## **CONSTITUTION**

Must be on file with SLIC.  
Any changes must be reported.

**4**

## **CURRENT ROSTER**

Maintain on Tukwut Trax. Must include Officers and minimum of 5 members.

**5**

## **MANDATORY TRAININGS**

President, Treasurer, & Advisor

**6**

## **CSU/CAMPUS POLICIES**

Open membership, student conduct, etc.

If there is ever a change to your President, Treasurer, Advisor, constitution, or org name outside of the Annual Recognition period, you must submit an Org Change Form.



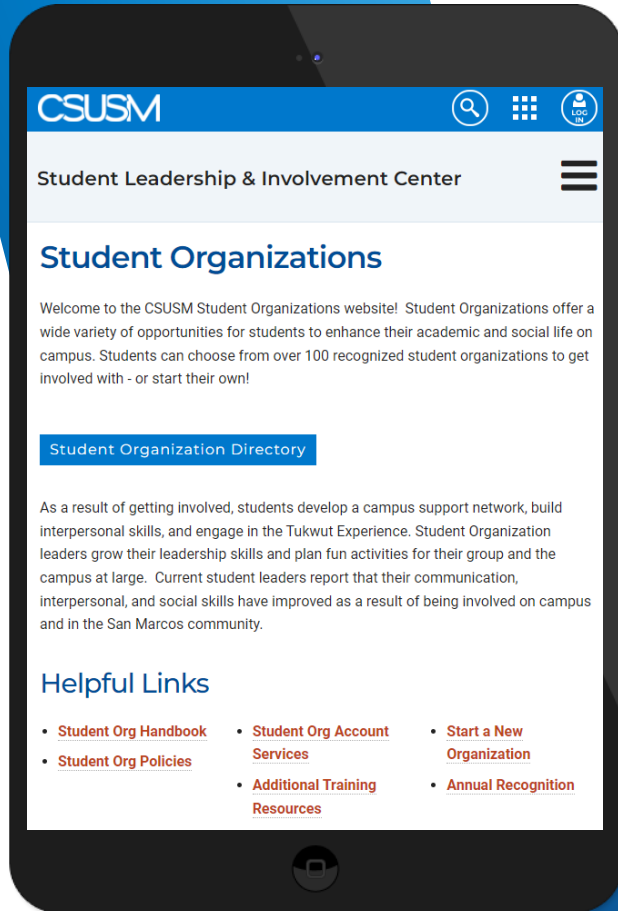

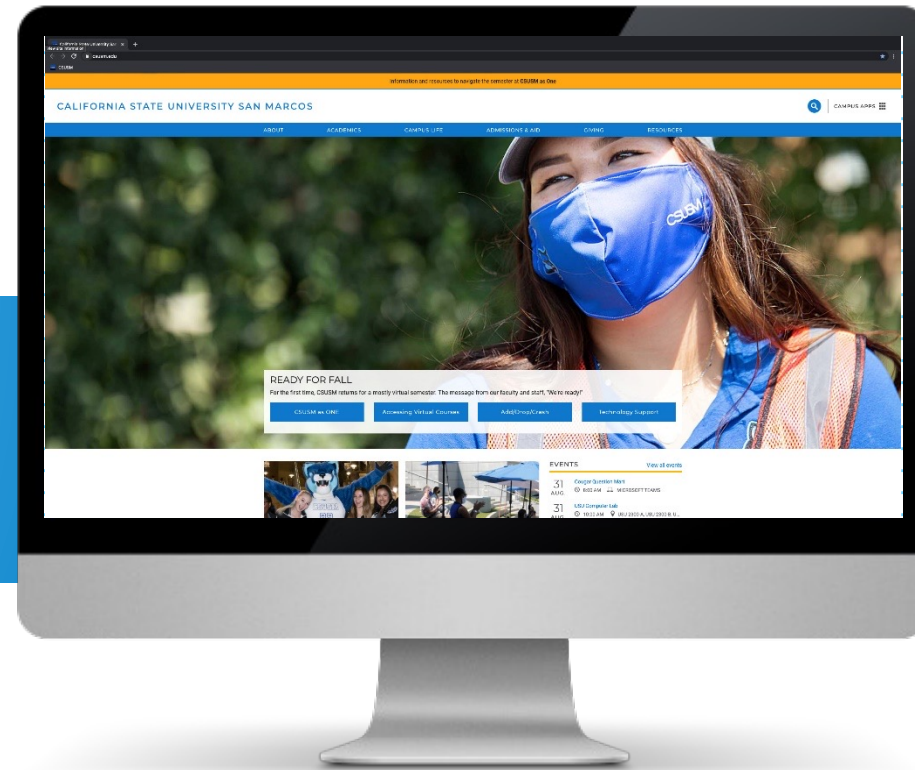

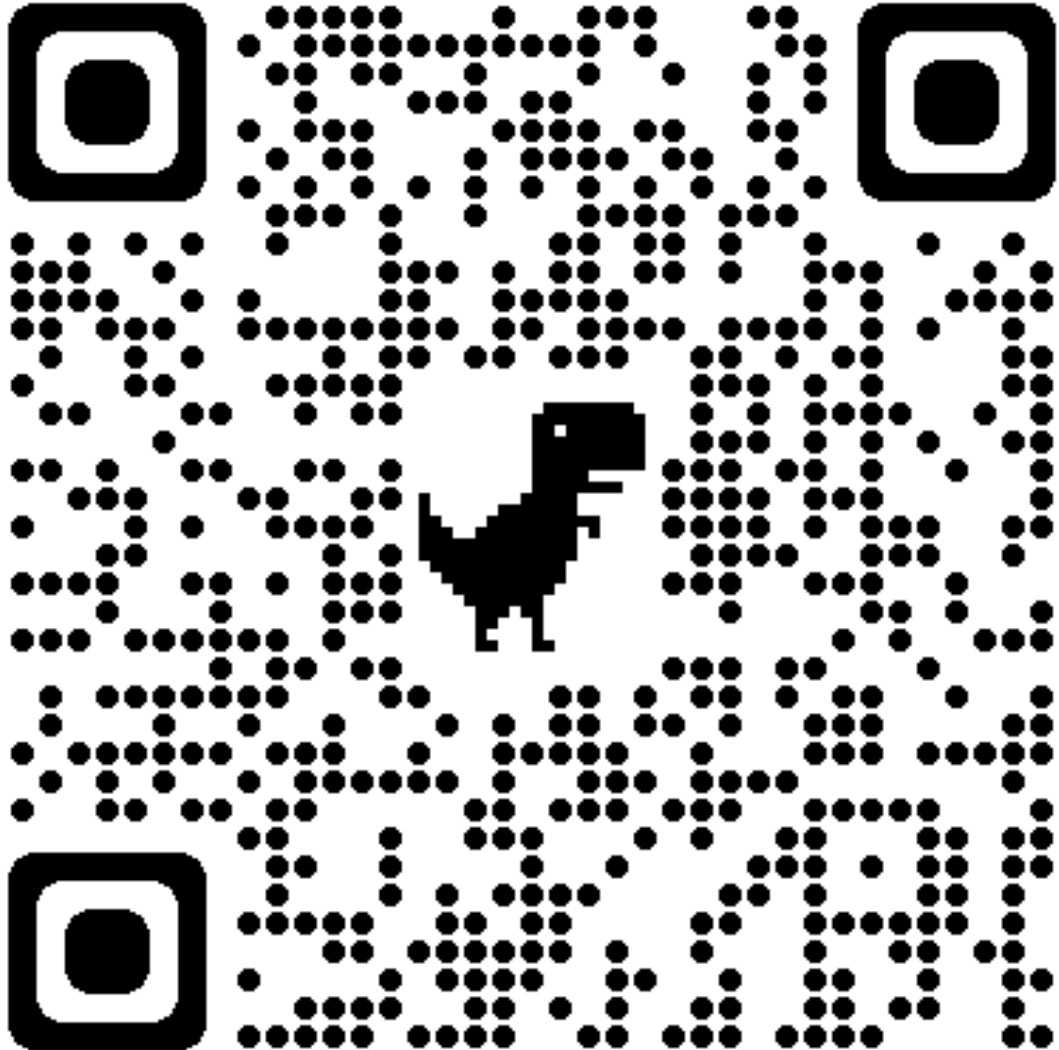
