1. For the CSUSM admissions application, please click on the following link: <https://calstate.liaisoncas.com/>
2. First time users, click the “Create an Account” link and follow the instructions to create your account. Be sure to write down your username and password to use at a later time.
3. Update the “Complete Your Profile” webpage with your specific information and click the Save Changes button.
