An individual vaping/smoking in your classroom is an obstruction to the educational process. **Faculty Affairs** advises:



Ask the student to stop.
If the student does not stop...



Ask the student to leave the classroom.
If the student does not leave the classroom...



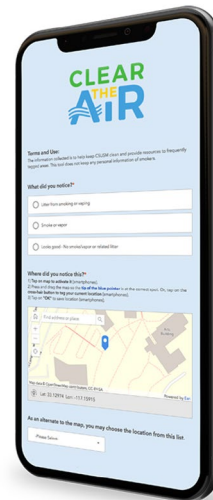
Call University Police and ask for assistance.



After class, complete a CCN referral to the Dean of Students Office.
