Simply follow these steps to get certified:

- 1. Fill out an interest form: SCOP Interest Form
- 2. Sustainability Manager will present the program to office/department
- 3. Fill out office and individual surveys
- 4. After completing the online forms, the Sustainability Manager will analyze the results
- 5. A mandatory audit will take place
- 6. After completing the program, a certification level will be granted (Green, Gold, Platinum)
- 7. You will be provided with images to advertise your success.
- 8. Complete post survey on office behavior change regarding sustainability.
- 9. Improve your certification level after 1 year, by re-certifying.
